Driving License & Background Check

Initial interview and meet with squad members.

Monthly meeting is the third Tuesday of the month at 7:30PM.

CPR certification- Professional Rescuers or Healthcare Providers from American Heart Assoc., American Red Cross, or National Safety.

First Aid Certification- AHA Heart Saver First Aid

Maintain at least a "C" average in all their school courses.

Attend at least 2 out of 3 drills, unless excused.

Monthly drill is the second Wednesday of the month at 7:30PM.

Respond to calls no later than 10PM on school nights.

First Responder

CPR certification- Professional Rescuer from American Heart Assoc. or American Red Cross

Complete 40 hour course, containing 7 modules with 21 lessons. Instructor led classes with hands on practical drills.

Certification Exam (optional) written & practical.

NREMT- National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians

Ambulance Attendant

Valid NJ Driver's License

Age- 18 years, no exceptions.

CPR certification- Professional Rescuer from American Heart Assoc. or American Red Cross

First Aid Certification- AHA Heart Saver First Aid

National Safety Council Course- CEVO- Coaching the Emergency Vehicle Operator.

Driver Training- 10 hours – Direct supervision of the Captain and/or Training

Lieutenant.

EMT

Age- 16 years by the first day of the program for Provisional EMT.

Age- 18 for EMT Basic.

CPR certification- Professional Rescuer from American Heart Assoc. or American Red Cross

EMT Basic Program Course- 120 hours classroom & 10 hours hospital ER.

EMT Basic Test- 365 days from end of class – 3 tries to pass - 70% passing grade.

5 Year Renewal Certification- 24 hours state mandated & 24 hours elective classes.

Annual state re-certifications in CPR, blood borne pathogens, CBRNE, HazMat.

One time certifications in N95 mask fit test, Do No Harm, Right to Know, ICS 100 & 700.

All uniforms & training costs paid for by the CFAS.

EMT requires 1 year commitment after certification.

Probationary period for all new members, regardless of certification, is 6 months.

Members can ride in ambulance at age 16, upon approval & direct supervision of an EMT.
